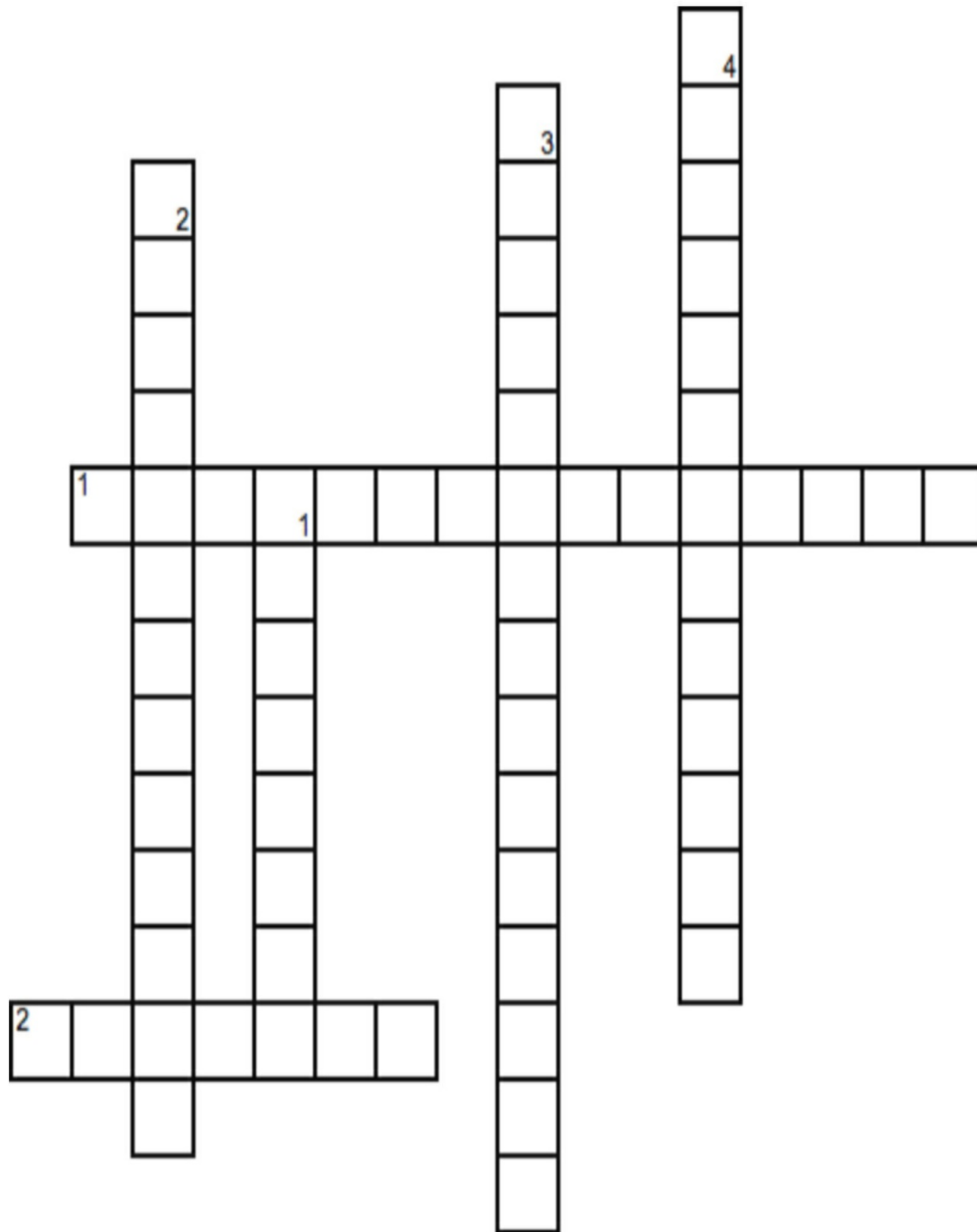


# Slang about Corruption
